



We strongly recommend the use of a stronger stiffer 3/16" diameter launch rod, when launching extra large rockets, cluster-engine birds such as the Centuri Saturn V, Saturn 1B and the 1/45th Little Joe, or any rocket with engine power greater than "D" class.

Inexpensive 3/16" x 36" piano wire may be found in many hobby shops . . Welding rod of this size is carried by hardware and building supply stores . . or you may order a special machined 2-piece rod from us, collapsable for easy storage.

Mini's have a nozzle (1) and casing pretty much like a standard engine, but scaled down in size for flying smaller-diameter rockets. Great for the altitude contests!
